- * MOST LIKELY TO HAVE LANGUAGE AND EDUCATIONAL BARRIERS.
- * MOST LIKELY TO BE YOUNG OR TO BE CHILDBEARING.
- * MOST OF THEM HAVE CHILDREN → BE U.S. CITIZENS AND WILL STAY THERE FOR THE REST OF THEIR LIFE
- = **IMPORTANT THAT THEIR PARENTS ARE INTEGRATING.**
- * AT THE FOUNDATION OF LOCAL ECONOMIES.
→ WORKING IN JOBS THAT ARE ESSENTIAL.
- * ESSENTIAL IN THE SHORT AND LONG TERMS WORK
