outh Africa is one of the most geographically varied countries in Africa. Located at the southern tip of the African continent, the 2,948 km coastline is bordered by the Indian Ocean to the east and the Atlantic Ocean to the west. Land borders include Namibia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Mozambique and Swaziland.

The administrative capital is Pretoria, the legislative capital is Cape Town and the judicial capital is Bloemfontein. The three largest cities are Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban



South Africa has 57.72 million inhabitants in 2018, divided into 80.2% Blacks, 8.8% Coloureds, 8.4% Whites and 2.5% Asians. It is also called "the rainbow nation", a concept invented by Desmond Tutu to designate the diversity of the South African nation.
